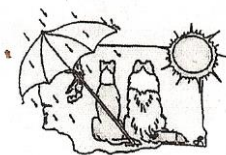

### **Non-Regular Breed Classes Involving Single Dog Entries Friday, Saturday a.m. & Saturday p.m. shows only**

Veteran Dog Class

Veteran Bitch Class

**Veteran Classes:** For dogs or bitches seven (7) years of age or older on the day of the show. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Class. 1<sup>st</sup> Veteran dog & 1<sup>st</sup> Veteran Bitch compete for Best of Breed.

**Each veteran entered shall receive a participation rosette.**

**Best Bred by Exhibitor** – For winners of the individual BBE classes (rough and smooth) combined.

### **Non-Regular Breed Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries Friday, Saturday a.m., & Saturday p.m. shows**

**Brace:** A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

#### **EXHIBITOR RULE CHANGE EFFECTIVE 01/01/2010**

Chapter 11, Section 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. *For complete details see Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 1.*

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSIFICATION

**FRIDAY, 2/22/19 & SATURDAY a.m. 2/23/19 - Collie Club of Washington offers the following Junior Showmanship Classes:**

**Novice Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in the Novice Class.

**Master Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year.

*All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.*

**Best Junior Handler:** Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

**SATURDAY, 2/23/19 p.m. and SUNDAY, 2/24/19 - Overlake Collie Club offers the following Junior Showmanship Classes:**

**Novice Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in the Novice Class.

**Master Class:** For boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year.

*All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.*

**Best Junior Handler:** Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. (PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ARE ENTERING UNDER THE CORRECT CLASS FOR YOUR AGE AND EXPERIENCE.)**

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767.

**BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.**

**SWEEPSTAKES**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes and is open to all Collies (Rough and Smooth) who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Classes will be divided by age and sex. **All entries in the sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class at this show. Sweepstakes will exclude AKC regular competition major point winners and AKC Champions of Record.** Entry fee is \$21 for each dog and entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry forms as for the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes". Professional handlers may handle without recompense and all prize money is the property of the owner.

**PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES OFFERED FOR EACH SEX:**

**CLASSIFICATION - VARIETIES COMBINED**

The club will retain 25% of entry fees for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be the Sweepstakes Fund and shall be divided as follows:

Best in Sweeps will receive 20% of each entry.

Runner Up to Best Sweeps will receive 15% of each entry.

Remaining 40% to be divided equally among dog and bitch 1st place class winners.
